Ahead of our visit to Bletchley park on Monday 17th March I just wanted to give final confirmation of our visit details. If you have any questions please do not hesitate to get in touch. Thank you for your support with our visit which I am sure will be a fantastic experience for your child.

Visit details:

- Students should be at school for 6.50am and wait in the Amphitheatre to be taken to the coach.
- The coach which will leave Penistone Grammar School at 7.10am
- We expect to arrive at Bletchley Park at around 10am, students will have a guided tour of the park, participate in a code breaking workshop based on the D-Day landings, have an opportunity to visit the gift shop and free time to re-visit any areas of the park of interest before leaving the park at 3pm to return home.
- The coach will return to school at approximately 5.30pm. We will ask students to send a text message when we are 30 minutes away from PGS to confirm arrangements for transport home.

Itinerary whilst at the park:

- Guided Tour Explore Bletchley Park
- Session: I to I D Day (Code breaking challenge)
- Lunch (1pm students may wish to bring a snack to have on the coach on the way down)
- Shop visit
- Explore Bletchley Park

Please note:

- Students will need to bring packed lunch. There will be no access to fridges so please make sure food goods do not need to be kept chilled. **Contents of packed lunch must not contain anything with Peanuts due to students with allergies.**
- Students will have the opportunity to visit the gift shop. Should they wish to do so they will need to bring spending money.
- Students do not need to wear school uniform but we ask that they are smartly dressed (no crop tops, ripped jeans, etc) but wear something comfortable as they will be spending a long time on the coach. They should also bring a jacket as although spring is arriving some parts of the park students will spend time in are not heated so may be cold.
- Students with travel sickness, asthma and allergies should make sure that they have their medication with them in a bag and have taken any necessary medication <u>before</u> we leave school.
