Your child will soon be given a username and password for something called Educake. Educake is an online homework and revision system for secondary schools. Students can use it on a PC, tablet or smartphone by going to <u>www.educake.co.uk</u>.

Teachers might set quizzes for homework or classwork in Educake. Quizzes can be retaken as many times as students want to improve their score. Every question is auto-marked, and students get instant feedback.

Educake makes revision easy and effective. Students can set themselves quizzes for more practice. They can see how they are doing on every topic and can identify areas to revise based on their progress.

If they're not sure where to start, the revision wizard shows them which topics they need to work on and creates personalised quizzes.
