Key Information

Use the PEELE structure for 9- and 15-mark questions. (point, explain, evidence/example, link, evaluate)

Conclude in 'assess' questions; do not sit on the fence (it hurts!) *I agree, I partially agree, to an extent I disagree...*

Refer to research context in application to methods questions in each point you make.

In the exam, attempt EVERY question.
