## GCSE PHOTOGRAPHY

#### **Key Dates & Exam Information**

**Exam Board: AQA** 

Component 1 (coursework) 60%

This is a portfolio of work produced for projects set by the class teacher since the beginning of Y10 and is worth **60% of the final GCSE grade**. It is still ongoing with a final deadline of **Tuesday 6<sup>th</sup> May 2025** and consists of sketchbook work, final prints, edits and other related outcomes.

Component 2 (10-hour exam) 40%

This is worth **40% of the final GCSE grade.** It is comprised of preparatory studies produced in response to a chosen exam question over a 12-week period and a final piece or pieces completed in 10 hours of exam time. **Upcoming exam sessions will take place during:** 

W/C Monday 28<sup>th</sup> April 2025 – 2 x 5h exam sessions (all day)\*

\*Students will remain in the Photography room for the whole day completing 5 hours of exam time plus their normal break and lunch time.

NB Preparatory studies MUST be handed in at the start of the first exam session which will take place – W/C Monday 28<sup>th</sup> April 2025.



#### **Assessment Objectives**

Components 1 and 2 are both assessed across 4 equally weighted assessment objectives:

AO1: Develop ideas through investigations, demonstrating critical understanding of sources (24 marks)

**AO2:** Refine work by exploring ideas, selecting and experimenting with appropriate media, materials, techniques and processes (24 marks)

AO3: Record ideas, observations and insights relevant to intentions as work progresses (24 marks)


**AO4:** Present a personal and meaningful response that realises intentions and demonstrates an understanding of visual language **(24 marks)** 

**NB.** Ensure that you complete all tasks outlined on the checklists supplied by your Photography teacher; this will ensure full coverage of the assessment objectives. Any gaps in your exam prep or coursework is likely to have a significant, negative impact on your final grade.




